• Grant Application

The APSA Fund for Latino Scholarship will select grantees according to criteria established for each funding cycle. The Fund's primary goal is to encourage and support the recruitment, retention, and promotion of Latina/o political scientists; our secondary goal is to support research on Latino politics in the United States. Grants will be made to individuals, institutions, and projects whose purposes most clearly match the goals of the Fund, and whose proposals most persuasively demonstrate capacity for successful completion. **NOTE: For 2012 the Selection Committee will give priority to proposals for individual travel grants of less than \$550. We will also consider institutional proposals for student recruitment and retention, to a maximum of \$1000, provided these include at least \$1000 of direct cost-sharing by the institution (i.e. exclusive of overhead or in-kind support).**
