



Terms and Conditions for APSA Research Department Publicly Available Datasets

Please review the following information carefully before downloading our datasets. By reading these terms and conditions, participants are agreeing to the terms of use set out below:

The American Political Science Association's Research Department has provided public datasets for specified years of Departmental, Graduate Placement, eJobs, Project on Women and Minorities surveys, and/or Membership administrative data to researchers *solely for the purposes of their research* as part of their personal or collective research, whether for personal research or research supported by grants from external institutions.

American Political Science Association allows any interested RESEARCHERS to download, clean, analyze APSA public datasets provided by the Research Department from specified years of Departmental, Graduate Placement, eJobs, Project on Women and Minorities surveys, and/or Membership administrative data. These terms and conditions stipulate that all RESEARCHERS who download and/or clean, analyze, or otherwise use the data will be responsible for:

- 1) **Data storage.** Upon receipt of data files from APSA, researchers will securely store datasets in a secure location accessible only to the researcher(s) and/or their assistant(s).
- 2) **Replication and data files from APSA surveys.** Decisions for posting the data and/or replication files, if applicable, are at the sole discretion of the researchers. APSA requests that researchers consider the norms of data access, transparency, and protection of human subjects when determining the best decisions for their research project.
- 3) **Data files from membership database.** RESEARCHERS agree not to post the files from membership database on data repositories or other publicly available sites.
- 4) **Privacy.** Researchers will take all reasonable steps to ensure the integrity and privacy of APSA data, with appropriate attendance to protecting the privacy of APSA members.
- 5) **Publication.** Researchers will provide written notice to the APSA Research Department of any publications resulting from this data set, within 90 days of acceptance notice or, if a non-peer reviewed outlet, within 90 days of publication.

APSA will be responsible for:

- 1) **Data provision.** APSA will provide individual level and/or aggregate level data and metadata in a manner useable by the researchers (e.g., csv, excel file).

APSA reserves the right to change or modify the above terms at any time. By reading and agreeing to these terms and conditions, participants are agreeing to the terms and conditions set out above.
